Your child has volunteered to take part in the Faith in Action Award Scheme through their school / parish.

The Faith in Action Award is a national initiative that aims to celebrate the work that many of our young people do in the name of faith, it also works to build bridges and forge strong links between Schools and Parishes.


As part of the award our students will need to engage in voluntary work, both in school and outside of school (for example, in parishes), as well as taking part in some theological reflections in their school / parish.

Alongside their hours of voluntary work and the theological reflections, young people are asked to complete a Journal during the award which details their own reflections and experiences of putting their faith into action. They will also be asked to complete a Final Project piece which will summarise their experience and can be in a format of their choosing (e.g. writing a song, a piece of artwork, a written reflection etc.). Both their Journal and their Final Piece will be submitted to the Moderation Panel. All elements of the award (including their voluntary hours, their Journal and their Final Piece) are submitted to the Nottingham Diocesan Catholic Youth Service, who facilitate this award. There is also an opportunity for your child to join a moderated online forum for their award. This platform features a facility for you to be kept up to date and to see what kinds of activities your child is taking part in should you wish to. In order to take part in the online forum you will need to provide an email address for your child (and a separate email address for the Parent / Carer summary to be sent) If you do not wish for your child to take part in the online platform then they will not be at a disadvantage and they will be able to access all of the materials through their school / parish The online platform (which uses Google Classroom) is externally moderated and is inline with the NDCYS Safeguarding and GDRP policies - both of which are available from NDCYS.com

Please fill in the form attached to register your child for the FIA award and return this to your school / Parish. This information will then be sent to NDCYS to complete the registration and start this exciting journey for you and your child.
